A meeting of the Parish Council was held at the Carlton in Lindrick Civic Centre, Long Lane, Carlton in Lindrick, Worksop, on Tuesday 10<sup>th</sup> March 2020.

### 102. BASSETLAW DISTRICT COUNCIL ISSUES

#### i) Response to Draft Plan Consultation

Members had been circulated with the formal response submitted to the District Council as part of the consultation process. It is anticipated that a further draft plan will be circulated in due course and that the Parish Council will receive a detailed response to the views and observations submitted.

ii) Wimpey Estate

Councillor Carrington-Wilde reported on officer's meetings with relevant members on plans which are being considered for works on the estate and on discussions relating to an appropriate role for the Parish Council. The importance on a multi-agency approach to identified needs was emphasised.

iii) Councillor Wilde agreed to pursue action relating to dog fouling problems at the King George IV playing field.

The Chairman reported on the Youth Centre being successful as Runner Up in a County Wide Youth initiative. The Chairman, Vice Chairman and Youth Leader had attended the presentation ceremony when certificates were presented to the finalists and successful participants.

106. PLANNING APPLICATION

i) 20/00175/HSE – Orchard Close, Carlton Hall Lane – Erect a two story side extension and single storey rear extension.

The Parish Council has no objection to this proposal providing the views of the Conservation Officer are adhered to and there is no adverse effect on neighbouring properties.

ii) 20/00198/HSE – 8 Costhorpe Villas – Erect single storey side and rear extension

The Parish Council has no objection to this proposal providing and there is no adverse effect on neighbouring properties.

iii) 20/00201/HSE – 156 Windsor Road – Erect two storey side and rear extension and single storey rear extension

The Parish Council has no objection to this proposal providing there is no adverse effect on neighbouring properties.

iv) 20/00155/LBA – Field House Farm – Church Lane – Formation of an additional bedroom in the first floor rear barn 1

The Parish Council has no objection to this proposal providing the views of the Conservation Officer are adhered to and there is no adverse effect on neighbouring properties.

v) 20/00206/LBA – The Cottage, Greenway – Erect 2 storey rear extension and single storey side extension

The Parish Council has noted that these proposals are made following consultation with the Conservation Officer. Providing the Conservation Officer is satisfied that the proposals have

accommodated all of his requirements the Parish Council has no objections.

However, access and egress proposals for vehicles still remain to be of concern to the Parish Council. It is obviously important that the views of the Highways Officer are considered carefully but Parish Councils concern both in relation to vehicles traversing in both directions on the highway and in relation to pedestrians safety remain unchanged. It is felt that road safety issues are still extremely relevant to the consideration and determination of this proposal
