Prior to commencement of Council's official business, the Chairman announced that in accordance with the Openness of Local Government Bodies Regulations, audio/visual recording and photography at Council meetings is permitted in accordance with the Council's protocol "Filming of Public Meetings".

44. POLICE ISSUES

A police representative circulated details of reported incidents in the Parish between the dates of 1st August 2016 and 30th September 2016. Councillor Scotthorne thanked the Police for their continued work with young people attending the Youth Centre and the Police Community Support Officer was thanked for her attendance.

46. SHALE WALTH FUND – CENTRAL GOVERNMENT CONSULTATION

The Association views on the distribution of any proposed Shale Wealth Fund were included in a letter circulated and addressed to the Department of Energy and Climate Change.
