A meeting of the Parish Council was held at the Civic Centre, Long Lane, Carlton in Lindrick, Worksop, S81 9AP on Tuesday 12th April 2016.

i) Councillor Scotthorne has alerted the District Council Environmental Health Department to ongoing concerns about the safety of the Costhorpe Development Site. The Health Department has agreed to contact the site owners on this issue.

ii) The Chairman and the Clerk reported on their attendance at Bassetlaw District Council's Rural Conference at Retford Town Hall.

The Conference dealt with the recently reported Devolution Deal and it is clear that the District Council is to become part of the Sheffield City Region Strategic Area under devolution arrangements being made with Central Government.

In addition, the conference discussed the new District Council Local Plan arrangements and the involvement of younger people on Parish Council affairs.
