

Carlton in Lindrick Parish Council

A meeting of the Parish Council was held at the Youth Centre, Lawn Road, Costhorpe, Worksop, on Tuesday 8th November 2016.

Present: Councillor C. Smith (Chairman) Councillors E. Banks, L. Billau, B. Bowles, K. Broad, C. Connolly, S. Jackson, W. Murdoch, P. Nicholson, S. Scotthorne and A. Williams.

District Councillor R. Carrington-Wilde and Peter Goulding (Parish Clerk) were in attendance.

Apologies for absence were received from Councillors V Bowles, S. Ludden, M. Pepper and County Councillor A. Rhodes.

Prior to commencement of Council's official business, the Chairman announced that in accordance with the Openness of Local Government Bodies Regulations, audio/visual recording and photography at Council meetings is permitted in accordance with the Council's protocol "Filming of Public Meetings".

54. DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST

Councillor S. Scotthorne declared an interest in issues relating to the Carlton Youth Centre.

55. MINUTES

RESOLVED that the minutes of the meeting held on the 11th October be approved subject to the word "wealth" being amended at minute 46.

56. NOTTS COUNTY COUNCIL ISSUES

Councillor Connolly expressed concerns at communication problems arising in the disposal arrangements for trade waste materials.

Councillor Scotthorne advised the Parish Council of continuing support being provided by the County Council for Youth Services.

57. BASSETLAW DISTRICT COUNCIL ISSUES

i) B.T. Telephones

B.T. has consulted the District Council regarding the current programme of intended public payphone removals.

There are currently 43 public payphones in the District 2 of which are within the Carlton Parish.

One is sited at Sycamore Road/Lime Tree Avenue and has been used on 3 occasions during the last 12 months, the other is sited in Long Lane and has been used 188 times during the last 12 months.

RESOLVED that

- 1) on the basis of usage level, B.T. be requested to continue the service at Long Lane
- 2) insofar as the service at Sycamore Road is concerned, the Council acknowledge the minimal use but request whether or not it would be feasible for the Parish Council to make a financial contribution towards the retention of the service.

ii) Other Issues

- a) Councillor Carrington-Wilde to enquire on the availability of funding for continuation of football facility provision from the Football Association.
- b) Councillor Wilde be thanked for prompt action on other District Council's Issues raised previously
- c) Councillor Wilde agreed to make further enquiries on the ongoing problem of fly-tipping at Crossley Hill Lane.

58. HUNDRED ACRE LANE BURIAL GROUND

Members had been circulated with a letter received from Ilett and Clerk (Solicitors) indicating final completion of the land purchase for use as a burial ground. Arrangements are now in hand for a meeting of the Burial Ground Sub-Committee to be held on the 7th December 2016 for design work and development costs to be discussed.

59. BURIAL GROUND A60 HIGHWAY

The Clerk informed members that the footpath scheme at the burial ground will be undertaken at the end of November/beginning of December.

60. PAYMENT OF ACCOUNTS

RESOLVED that the payments schedule dated 8th November 2016 be approved.

61. NEIGHBOURHOOD PLAN/BASSETLAW LOCAL PLAN

The District Council is staging a consultation event at the Civic Centre from 4pm to 8pm on the 15th November 2016. The Local Plan will have a direct effect on the Parish Neighbourhood Plan proposals and members are invited to attend to express their views.

Councillor Barry Bowles reminded members of forthcoming Remembrance Day Occasions in the Village.

63. YOUTH CENTRE TOILET REFURBISHMENT Minute 53 refers)

The Clerk presented two quotations received for this work. Company A has quoted £28,848 which includes payment to sub-contractors for some of the work and Company B has quoted £14,300 for all of the work required. Members considered the level of specification required for a building in public use and it was
