A meeting of the Parish Council was held at the Civic Centre, Long Lane, Carlton in Lindrick, Worksop, S81 9AP on Tuesday 8th March 2016.

80. POLICE/PUBLIC PARTICIPATION

Police representatives were welcomed to the meeting.

Reference was made to the continuing personnel reductions being made because of budgetary constraints. The PCSO's present were thanked for their attendance in the face of increased demands on the service and their report on activities within the Parish was noted.

84. 90TH BIRTHDAY CELEBRATION- H.M.QUEEN ELIZABETH II

The Tower Mint Limited Company is to produce a Commemorative Medal for Schools and Councils. A sample of the medal which is presented in a bespoke royal blue gold embossed card surround within a protective perspex case was circulated to members. It is anticipated that the cost of purchasing a medal to be presented to every child attending the two Carlton-In-Lindrick Schools would be in the region of £700.

RESOLVED that

- (2) an additional small quantity of medals be purchased for sale to members of the community.

85. CIVIC CENTRE – TELECOMMUNICATIONS PROPOSAL

The Clerk reported on a meeting with representatives of “Shares Access” which is a Company undertaking activities to improve mobile telephone signals in various parts of the country. The company has identified the Civic Centre site as being appropriately located for installation of an internal mast to improve signals in the Carlton Area. Currently the company is offering a financial payment of £25,000 to install a mast on the Civic Centre site. The company will be responsible for obtaining planning approval and will undertake all the legal requirements in relation to the proposal.

RESOLVED that

- (1) the report be noted
- (2) discussions on this matter continue and further information be obtained in relation to the dimensions of the mast.
