Whilst the Parish Council on an “every day” basis seeks to continue important Village Services at the Civic Centre and the Youth Centre in addition to supporting other local voluntary organisations, additional time and resources have focused on the provision of new burial ground facilities at Hundred Acre Lane and on the establishment of a Neighbourhood Plan for the Village.

A recent national survey has highlighted a lack of preparation by most parishes in the country in providing land for future cemetery needs. Carlton in Lindrick is one of a small percentage of local council’s being recognised nationally as an authority which has prepared for this need.

In addition, being prepared and planning for the future development of the village has been at the forefront of issues being addressed through the preparation of a Neighbourhood Plan. Elsewhere in this edition are details of how you can comment on the Draft Plan which will be used when planning applications are considered for years to come. Your views are important and public consultation events have been arranged.

If you have views or question on any Parish Council activities you can either raise them with me at the Civic Centre or by attending Council Meetings which take place on the second Tuesday of each month at 7pm at the Civic Centre in Long Lane. The Council meets every month except for August.
