Progress continues to be made on the preparation of a Neighbourhood Plan for the Parish and District Council Officers are currently undertaking work to determine the next steps in the process to meet the desires and ideas received when consultations were made with the local community.

The Steering Group is still meeting regularly to discuss and finalize proposals which will be made available for public inspection when they are complete.

Authorised improvement works to toilet facilities at our Youth Centre in Lawn Road have now been completed and the Parish Council continues to work with the Notts County Council to ensure that our young people can continue to enjoy an excellent facility within the Village. In addition, the outcome of applications made for external funding to support improvement work at the Civic Centre is awaited and if the applications are successful extensive refurbishment and improvement work will be undertaken within 12 months.

Parish Councillors and Civic Centre Trustees, all of whom contribute their time and expertise free of charge are endeavouring to ensure that quality standards of community service are provided at the Centre which in addition to accommodating Parish Council staff presents a varied programme of local entertainment, accommodates wedding and family celebrations and houses local businesses.

We are approaching the start of a new financial year (April/March 2014/15) and as usual the Parish Council will be carefully monitoring its income and expenditure activity.

Regular meetings are held to ensure that financial control is maintained and best use is made of resources. Established budgetary control procedures are in place and Council activities will be examined by external auditors so that the local community can be assured that its local council is operating within its legal limits and in the best interest of local residents.

You too can familiarize yourself with Council activities by attending Council meetings which are open to the public and take place at 7pm on the second Tuesday of each month (except August when we don't meet) at the Civic Centre.
