



## CARLTON IN LINDRICK PARISH COUNCIL

Members of the public attending recent Council meetings have raised a number of issues of concern relating to specific highway matters and other environmental concerns. In addition, the attention of Council staff has been brought to areas of maintenance and repair needing action and it is reassuring to know that letters and messages of thanks for our prompt action have been received from those affected.

The Parish Council is embarking on a busy period of activity.

During the next few months, the External Auditor will submit his opinion on the Council's efficiency, specifications will be drawn up for grass cutting, burial ground and garden maintenance contracts and in addition quotations will be sought for the development of the new burial ground in Hundred Acre Lane. In September the budgetary process for 2018/19 income and expenditure will be commenced and once again Council members will endeavour to support its current services without imposing any increase in the Council Tax Level. This for the 5<sup>th</sup> Year in succession.

Recently the Parish Council in cooperation with the County Council and the North Notts College have approved plans for external improvement work at the Youth Centre in Lawn Road which will considerably improve the grounds at the Centre. It will also provide experience and training for college students undertaking the work and will enhance activities at the Centre for young members and parents. The Parish Council is very happy to encourage this joint scheme which promotes a much valued community asset and always welcomes the opportunity to work in partnership with other organisations for the benefit of the local community.

Finally a note about the recently held family fun Day at the Civic Centre. The weather was good, the attendance was good and it would seem that a number of activities were thoroughly enjoyed by local families.

The Parish Council wishes to express its thanks to Helen Brown (Civic Centre Manager) and her staff for all the hard work and commitment they contribute to ensure an enjoyable event and thanks to all the additional volunteers who helped on the day.

Work on next year's event has already started!!!
