PARISH COUNCIL

Arrangements have now been concluded for the consecration of the Hundred Acre Lane Cemetery which will be brought into use shortly.

A consecration service was conducted by Bishop Tony Porter, Bishop of Sherwood and his diocese colleagues on the 5th November 2019 followed by hospitality refreshments at the Parish Centre.

The Reverend Mark Orr (St Johns Parish Church) hosted the attendance of the diocesan officials and Parish Councillors and representatives of local organisations were present at the service.

The Parish Council has raised a number of community issues recently on services provided by other agencies. Concerns have been brought to the attention of the Notts County Council on inadequate supervisory action on local school buses, discussion continues with the police on local crime levels and District and County Council members continue their attendance at Parish Council Meetings so that relevant discussion can be held.

As Christmas approaches, the usual festive activities are being arranged for the young and not so young at the Civic Centre and the Parish Council continues to support activities at the Centre and at our Youth Centre in Lawn Road.
