

PARISH COUNCIL

Members of the Parish Council extended a warm and friendly welcome to our new Parish Priest the Reverend Mark Orr who attended the September meeting of the Parish Council.

Following informal introductions, Reverend Orr stayed to listen to all of the Council's discussions which extended from issues relating to maintenance contracts to the consideration of observations on a major planning application received for a significant residential development on the former Firbeck Colliery Site at Costhorpe.

As readers will be aware, the Parish Council has for many years supported proposals for the development of this site and although the current proposal involves highway, conservation and leisure considerations the Parish Council did unanimously support a recommendation to approve the application.

County and District Council representatives were also present at the meeting to report on current initiatives and work being undertaken in the Village by those authorities.

Elsewhere in this edition of the Carlton News there is opportunity for residents to make their views known on other land holdings which have been put forward by landowners to the District Council for designation for future housing development.
