

Maintenance work on the rose beds on the grassed area opposite the Blue Bell on the A60 has now become part of the Parish Council's responsibility. Work will be undertaken on the beds in October/November this year to ensure a more attractive display for the summer of next year. Already work has been undertaken to maintain the trees alongside the site so that the whole area is improved aesthetically for residents and those travelling through the village on the A60 highway.

The Parish Council continues to provide an appropriate pitch facility at the King George V Playing field for the Carlton Knights Junior Football Club who have repeated successes in local junior football leagues. The Parish Council works with the Club Officials to encourage a sporting focus for young people in the Parish and that support extends to providing premises and other support for wide ranging and life style training for those who attend the Youth Centre in Lawn Road. Such activities pave the way for responsible citizenship in adult life and the excellent work undertaken by adults and volunteers with younger members of our society should not be overlooked or taken for granted.

The Council endeavours to ensure pleasing environmental conditions on grasscutting, grounds maintenance and burial grounds maintenance excellent communication opportunities with our County and District Council colleagues.
