#### CLERK'S REPORT

##### (a) Tour of Britain Cycle Race (Minute 7 Environmental Working Party refers)

Members will be aware that this event took place on the 6<sup>th</sup> September 2017 and that the Tour passed through the village at lunchtime on that day. Member of the Environmental Working Party discussed the event and agreed that some form of welcome to the Tour should be publicised by the Parish Council and as a result 3 banners were purchased for siting at various points along the route. The cost of the banners was £180.00 in total and members are requested to approve this expenditure.

##### (b) Burial Ground, Hundred Acre Lane

One of the Planning Conditions included in the approval for the site was that temporary fencing and hedge planting had to be undertaken prior to any further part of the development commencing. Members are informed that the 300 meter length of fencing and hedge planting is about to/has commenced and will cost £6,720 net of VAT. Payment for this part of the project will be allocated from the Council's Burial Ground Reserve Budget with the remainder of the development being the subject of a further loan from the Public Works Loan Board. Loan details will be reported to the Council when final development costs have been ascertained.

Members are requested to approve expenditure on the fencing and hedge works and note the remainder of the report.

##### (c) Tender process – Grasscutting and Garden Works

Contractors have been circulated with a detailed specification for this Contract which will be for a 5 year period 2018-2023. Contractors are requested to submit bids by the 12 noon on Tuesday 26<sup>th</sup> September 2017 for the Council to determine the successful bid at the November meeting.
