

Carlton in Lindrick Neighbourhood Plan (Review): Reg. 16 Consultation

Overview

The reviewed Carlton in Lindrick Neighbourhood Plan has been formally submitted to Bassetlaw District Council in accordance with Regulation 15 of the Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations 2012. Bassetlaw District Council is now consulting statutory bodies and interested parties on this submission, in accordance with Regulation 16 of the same regulations. Once the consultation has closed, all representations received will be collated and provided to an independent examiner who will examine the Neighbourhood Plan in accordance with the relevant regulations. When completed, the examiner will produce an examination report that will identify any proposed modifications to the Neighbourhood Plan. The examiner will also recommend whether they feel the Plan should proceed to a public referendum. If you would like to be notified of the outcome of the examination process, please include an indication to this effect as part of your representation.
